After School Activities Descriptions

1. After school Program - Session 1 - These clubs are offered by Rilke Schule through various Rilke Schule Teachers. During this time students will have the opportunity to complete their homework with the help of a teacher and/or engage in other academic activities. Students will be group by adjoining grade levels.
2. After school Program - Session 2 - These clubs are offered by Rilke Schule through various Rilke Schule Teachers. During this time students will have the opportunity to get exercise, play cooperatively with students in various grades, learn or practice seasonally appropriate outdoor games.
3. After school Program - Session 3 - These clubs are offered by RSI through Herr Helgesen. During this time students will have the opportunity to participate in reading aloud, singing German and English songs, journaling, crafts, art, dance, games, and/or computer.
4. American Sign Language (ASL) - This club is provided by ASL Concepts and provides students with the opportunity to learn American Sign Language in a fun and active way.
5. Ballet - Introduction to Ballet offered by Beatriz Lavagnino Ballet.
6. Band Club - Will be offered by the school through Frau Hilde who offered Flute and Clarinet club last year. This year she will be adding the trumpet and trombone to form a band. This club is open to middle school students only.
7. Basketball - The World Sports League will offer basketball skills, conditioning, cardio for the older kids Basketball style camp with lots of fun activities for the younger kids.
8. Bricks 4 Kidz - Will be offered by Brick 4 Kidz. The sessions are hands-on classes where students learn the fundamentals of S.T.E.M using Lego bricks. We use Lego motors, battery packs and tech Lego bricks. The club will be covered though by other volunteers and German interns.
9. Canvas Club - Will offered by Arctic Crown Canvas. The Canvas and Mixed Media Club is instructor led and student driven as we explore Acrylic, Watercolor and Alcohol Ink media applied to different surfaces. We will work with glass, ceramic tile, Yupo, watercolor paper and stretch canvas. Our subjects will include landscapes, seascapes, mountains, trees, Pop Art, and Alaskan Animals. We provide all supplies and your child provides the spark! Wednesday's club will focus more on Alaskan Animals while Friday's club will be composition and landscapes. The supplies are consumable, which means the student takes home at least one canvas each session. This club meets 34 times on Wednesday and Friday this semester.
10. Computer Club - This club is offered by Rilke Schule through Herr Helgesen. The club offers students to work on the Lexia reading program and/or the Math Whiz mathematical program. The club helps students reach grade level for reading, improve language arts performance, both in school and for state-wide testing, and to get students on grade level in mathematics and improve scores on math tests.
11. Drama Club (2-8 grades) - Is offered by Frau Keller who took over for Frau Sanders last school year. She will be operating under Theatrical Adventures. The Fall performance is The Baker Street Irregulars by Flip Kobler and Cindy Marcus. The roles of Finnegan, Alaska, Phoebe, Quinn, Wiggins, Lestrade, and Eliza will be reserved for grades 4th-8th due to the amount of lines they will need to memorize. At this time only the cast members listed above will be the members of drama meeting on Wednesdays from 3:15-4:15, no registration at this time and no additional cost. If your child is registered for another club at that time and are selected for the cast, contact Rilke Clubs for a prorated credit. All members will meet Tuesday and Thursdays. *Lines and scenes will be modified as needed to ensure the best play for your youngsters is put together. The club is offered in two consecutive parts, so please make sure to register for both.
12. Drama Club (K-1) - Is offered by Frau Keller. Due to the overall popularity of Drama Club and being mindful of the attention span of younger children, Frau Keller is offering a Drama Club on Monday and Wednesday to develop age appropriate mini-productions for the Fall performance.
13. Fantasy Gaming (5th & up) - This club is offered by Arctic Crown Canvas. The club runs from 2:15 pm-6 pm on Fridays, so please make sure to register for all four parts. The long duration of the club is designed to allow for the instructions, set up and a good amount of time to actually engage in the game. The club will start the semester off learning how to play Dungeons and Dragons, adding other card and board games within this genre, as the semester progresses and based on participant interest.
14. Förderkurs Club - Will be offered by SamstagsSchule by the Director Gensine Metzger-Jacobs. For students struggling or needing extra support with German language.
15. German Learning Games - Will be offered by SamstagsSchule by the Director Gensine Metzger-Jacobs. The club will focus on practicing German vocabulary and grammar, but also explore German culture. Students will play a variety of card, board and co-operation games in German. Games will keep the skill level and age of the students in mind. Wer ist dran? Du bist dran!

16. Journalism Club-Will be offered by the RSI through Caitlin Elam an experienced writer and journalist. The club will meet twice a week and students must be enrolled for both days. The club participants will produce a newspaper written entirely by the students. The club will help students explore a range of styles of journalism, the importance of journalistic ethics, differentiating between fact and opinion within an article, and photography. This club is open to middle school students only.
17. Orchestra-This club is offered through Frau Wilkins Suzuki program and is only open to students that played in the Orchestra last year or with express permission from Frau Wilkins.
18. Mindfulness and Meditation - This is a Kidding Around Yoga class for beginning yogis K-2 with extra time for meditation and mindfulness practice (includes 20-30 minute meditation/relaxation break). Club is offered Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays and is open to New and Returning Kindergarten through 2nd grade students. (Club will have different practice than 4:15pm KAY Club, so yogis attending multiple sessions will not have repeated class in the same day and they will have time for a short comfort break for water/snack/bathroom between clubs.)
19. Reading Club-These clubs are offered by Rilke Schule by Frau Robertson. Students will read and discuss the books on the Battle of the Books lists for their respective grades.
20. Rhythm & Movement - Basic gymnastics in preparation for Ballet offered by Beatriz Lavagnino Ballet.
21. Rilke Outdoor 4-H - 4-H empowers youth to reach their full potential, working and learning in partnership with caring adults. The decades-old slogan of “Learn By Doing” and the core values of Head, Heart, Hands, Health are at the center of everything club members do, and leaders teach. 22. Smart Start-This club is offered by Rilke Schule through various Rilke Schule teachers. The club is housed in the gym and provides an opportunity for students to exercise, work on homework, and engage in cooperative play.
23. Travel Club-This club is offered through Rilke Schule by Frau Robertson and is for 8th graders only that have received permission Frau Robinson to join the club.
24. Violin-This club is offered through Frau Wilkins Suzuki program and will only be offered to students currently enrolled on violin for Fall 2018.
25. Visual Journaling/Sketchbook - Will be offered by Arctic Crown Canvas. The art of expression is both written and drawn. Some writing is expected. This is a two hour club with an optional sketchbook component. We provide journals, daily challenges and doodles to spark interest in your child. Our lessons include changing numbers and letters into creatures and using zentangles to create whimsical doodles. We also provide easy to follow drawings based on your child’s interest. The journal will be released to the student on the last day we meet. The sketchbook project is sponsored by the Brooklyn Art Library. The sketchbook cost is not included in the price of this club. If you would like your child to participate, please purchase a sketchbook (\$30) from this link (<https://www.brooklynartlibrary.com> sketchbook project) and have them bring it to class. We will keep track of the sketchbook for them and then submit it to the Brooklyn Art Library on March 29, 2019. Your child’s sketchbook will become part of the permanent collection. This project is an extension of visual journaling that will be shared with the public. This club meets 36 times on Tuesday and Thursday this semester
26. Yoga-Every Kidding Around Yoga class offers a complete, age-appropriate Yoga, Meditation, and Mindfulness practice including breathing instruction, relaxation techniques, stretching and strengthening poses, all using fun-filled music, games, and imagination.
